

CCF Human Rights Competition – Photo

Theme: It is Important to Vote

Rules and Guidelines

The Citizens' Constitutional Forum calls on individuals with a candid eye to capture a picture to present the theme, "It is important to vote."

The invitation is extended to anyone with their artistic eye and passion for color, to submit a picture that relays a powerful story related to the theme of the competition.

What should I capture?

Anyone with a digital device that can capture and edit a digital photo is welcome to submit their entry.

Participants are encouraged to be creative with the style of their photo entry

All submissions must incorporate some versatility by combining texts, images that allows for a good flow of captivating content. The accompanying caption will summarize the story that the picture depicts.

The contest is open to interested and eligible individuals.

What are the rules of the photo competition?

- Applications are open to Fiji residents from the age of 14 and over. All eligible participants under the age of 18 must provide signed consent from parent or guardian – proof of consent must be uploaded to the provided online form.
- All entries submitted must be a clear digital photo.
- Entries that contain explicit images, hate speech and the use of vulgar language will automatically be disqualified.
- Entries must not include or show persons who are under the age of 18 without prior written consent of their parents or legal guardians.
- CCF has the right to publicize the winners through the use of media.
- Photo entries will be utilised by CCF for advocacy, publications and organizational activities on the organisation's platforms. Photographers will be credited accordingly.



- Due to COVID-19 developments around the country, CCF will not be accepting hard copy submissions. **Participants must strictly follow COVID-19 safety guidelines as specified by the Ministry of Health.**

What is the marking criteria?

- All entries must be an original digital photo linked to the theme of the competition
- Participants are only allowed to make one entry which will be deemed final. Revised versions will not be accepted.
- Participants must submit a single photo that depicts their understanding of the theme. Entries must be accompanied with a creative caption related to the theme.
- No copyrighted material images may be used for this contest unless you own copyright or have a license to use the material.
- No banners or slogans of political parties should be used in your production

How Do I Submit My Photo

Category	Prizes
Ages 14 to 19	Top 3 Win \$200 each
